NBIS TRANSITION

The National Background Investigation Services (NBIS) is here, and DCSA is currently onboarding companies into the new system.

DCSA describes NBIS as a one-stop-shop IT system for end-to-end personnel vetting — from initiation and application to background investigation, adjudication, and continuous vetting. It will replace several current systems, including DISS and SWFT.

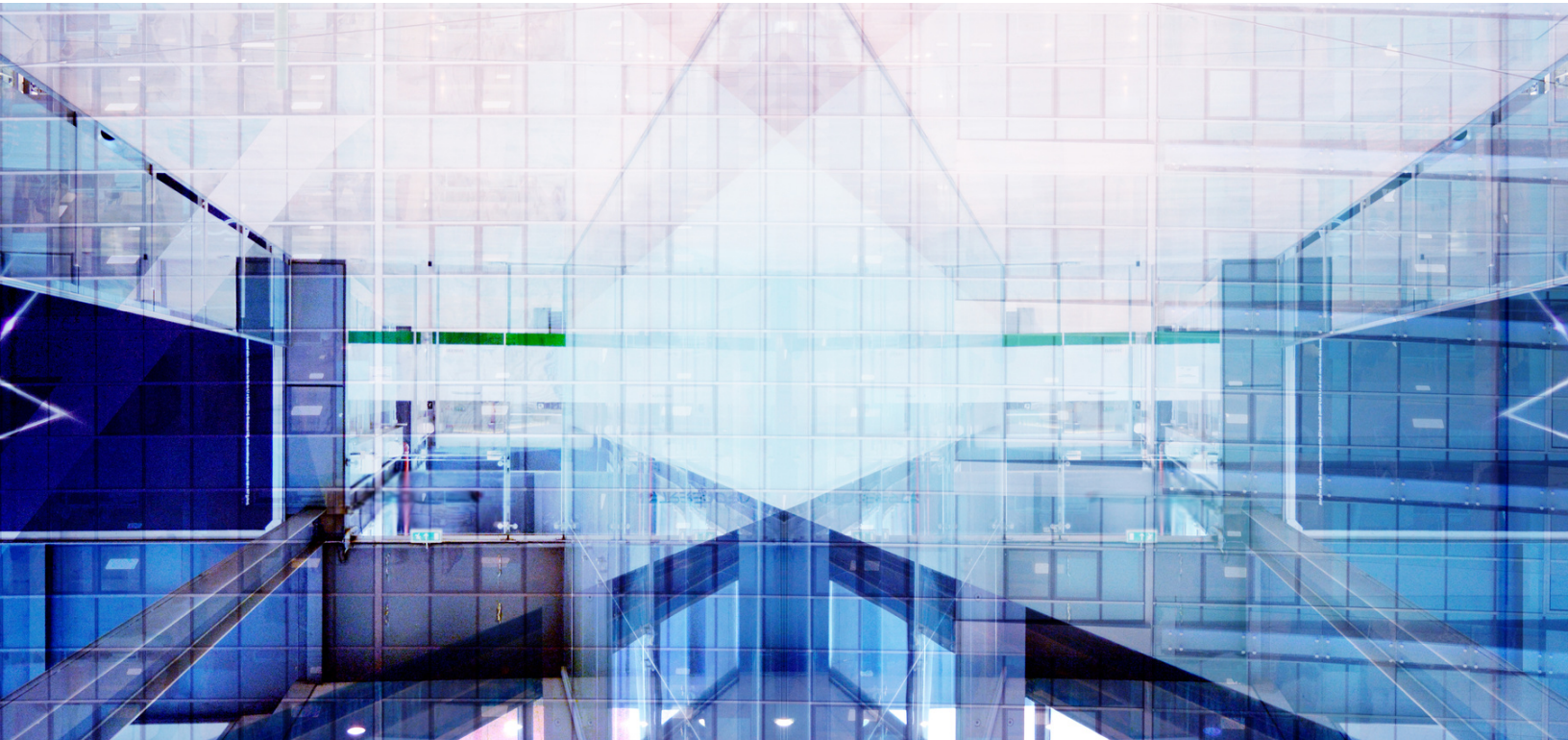

CAC CARD PROCEDURES

While CAC card procedures may differ depending on the contract, they all involve the submission of a DD1172-2 to request the issuance of a CAC card. Individuals need to be vetted with a security clearance or government-initiated background check. CAC cards provide access to certain government systems and allow individuals to access a military base without a visitor pass.

DEBRIEF AN EMPLOYEE

Employees must know their obligations to protect national security information, even after they have left employment with a DoD contractor. We recommend a debrief process and signature document for any employee leaving a company, whether cleared or not. DCSA frequently asks to see records of the debrief during an audit, so having a process to debrief and store these records is critical. We can help.
