CAC Card Procedure

Common Access Cards are issued by the Department of Defense to grant access to government systems and/or military installations and bases. Individuals who require a CAC card must undergo a background check and then be approved for their CAC card.

They will visit a RAPIDS office (<https://idco.dmdc.osd.mil/idco/>) to receive their CAC and create a PIN number that can be used for login to government systems.
